INSTRUCTION ON ORGANIZING THE INTERNATIONAL RACE "ULAANBAATAR MARATHON"

One. Purpose:

1.1 The purpose of organizing the international race "Ulaanbaatar Marathon" is to develop sport of race in the home country, promote the capital city for the countries of the world, increase number of citizens who are nonprofessionals and interested in race and give opportunities to youth and adolescent to open their internal resources and opportunities, achieve their goals, have patience and build sportsmanship, physical and spiritual upbringing.

1.2 Framework: 25-30 thousand citizens including foreign and domestic citizens, who go in for race, students of universities and colleges, secondary school students will involve in the international race "Ulaanbaatar Marathon".

Two. Organizers, co-organizers and sponsors of "Ulaanbaatar Marathon"

General organizers: The Governor's Office of the capital city, Ministry of Culture, sports and tourism, Department for Physical Culture and Sports of Ulaanbaatar city, Authority for Tourism of the capital city

Co-organizers: Ministry of Education and science, Mayor's Office of the capital city, National Olympic Committee of Mongolia, Mongolian Athletics Federation, Mongolian Ultra Marathon Federation, "Ar Mongol" travel group, Mongolian Youth Association, Mongolian Student Association

Three. Procedure and term of organization:

3.1 Opening ceremony of the international race "Ulaanbaatar -Marathon" will be held at 09:00 o'clock on 7 June 2014 at the square named after Chinggis Khan.

Race: Start will be from the Chinggis Khan square, race will be conducted in its routine and the finish of race will be at the Chinggis Khan square.

Competition - 1. Marathon:

Semi-marathon /21095 m/ and full marathon /42190 m/ competitions will be organized among marathon runners aged over 18.

Registration fee will be taken from runners. Confirming registration of runners who paid fee, pectoral number, t-shirt, napkin, introduction and race routine will be issued. Pectoral numbers will be issued to runners who do not pay any fee and the runners who do not take the number, will not be held at a finishing line and their success will not be considered. Also medical service and aid will not be taken.

Competition – 2. Race of nonprofessionals:

Race of nonprofessionals will be organized in 4 age categories in 4 distances.

- Up to 17 4000 m /among only male and female nonprofessionals/
- 18-35 8000 m, /among only male and female nonprofessionals/
- 36- 49 5000 m /among only male and female nonprofessionals/
- Over 50 4000 m /among only male and female nonprofessionals/

Pectoral numbers will be issued to runners. Registration of race participants will be organized from 20 April 2014 through 06 June.

Individuals, families and organizations will be involved in the registration.

Four. Prize:

Athletes who take the initial 3 parts in the race on "Ulaanbaatar - Marathon" will be awarded by golden, silver and bronze medals, honorary letters and reward.

Golden, silver and bronze medals, honorary letters and reward will be awarded to male and female athletes who run in semi and full marathon in the distance of 21095m, 42190m and take 1-6th places, memorial medals, honorary letters and reward will be awarded to male and female athletes who can finish your race.

Golden, silver and bronze medals, honorary letters and reward will be awarded to male and female athletes who run in the distance of 4000 m, 5000m, 8000m and take 1-3rd places, memorial medals, honorary letters and reward will be awarded to male and female athletes who can finish your race.

Five. Registration

5.1. Registration will be done from 20 April 2014 through 17:00 o'clock on 6 June /at the suite #13, 1st floor, Cultural Central Palace/ in a room of the Department for Physical Culture and Sports of Capital city. Registration will be done in presence and online.

Foreign and domestic citizens who are interested in participating in the race will complete registration form correctly and truly and stick photo.

5.2. Foreign athletes, health insurance, and it will come. Included in the registry participants ID and his birth year, month, day of confirmation documents and ran a distance athletes participating physicians agreed that the letters have arrived.

5.3. Pectoral number will be issued to participants of the race of nonprofessionals. The runners, who do not take the pectoral number, will not be held at a finishing line and their success will not be considered.

5.4. Semi and full marathon participants will be involved under the control of physicians and blood pressure will be measured before start.

5.5. Participants in other races will involve in physician's examination 3 days before the race and pulse and pressure will be measured.

5.6. The organization which will organize participation in the competition, will bear accommodation, meal and around fare of athletes who are participating from the local areas.

5.7. Entrance and exit movement of Chinggis square will be limited and closed at 8:30 o'clock and thus the race participants will be at start line at Chinggis Khan square before 8:30 o'clock. Depending on sequence in registration of runners they will be placed at start line.

5.8. Race day registration will not, but on 06 March 2014, 07-th race coming from foreign countries or other provinces to participate in the pre-registered players 07:00 - 08:00 at the badge number issued.

5.9. Registration form and account number for race fee payment are placed at www.sport.ub.gov.mn.

5.10. Run 42190 and 21095 m, 8000 m distance racing participants 15000 /fifteen thousand/, 4000 m and 5000 m, space racing the participants 2000 / two thousand / fee to pay.
